My dear David

Following our conversation regarding the eventual disposal of my Library, I would like to confirm the conditions under which I offered these books to the Baillieu Library:

1. That my Library would remain intact, housed in one room at the Baillieu Library.
2. That the books would be used as a Reference Library.
3. That the portion of the Library housed at 2 Haverbrack Avenue, Malvern, would not be available until my wife indicated that she was closing the house or on her death.
4. That the portion housed at 95 Collins Street, Melbourne, would be available when the office was closed or upon my death.

I would be glad to learn whether the Council of the Melbourne University is willing to accept the books in my Library and, if so, upon the conditions set out above.
